The Polio Research Committee is calling for research proposals supporting the [Polio Endgame Strategy 2022-2026](#). Research proposals supporting the strategic plan may be submitted to the Committee for review and funding. Preference will be given to proposals developed by GPEI partner agencies and their research collaborators. However, other institutions may also submit proposals if they address our research priorities.

The current priority of the Polio Research Committee is to generate new data or information in the following areas:

Vaccine schedule immunogenicity
Surveillance
Product development
Epidemiology/virology
Monitoring & evaluation
Basic immunology
Containment

Submission of proposals

The deadline for submission of proposals for the next round of review is 31 March, 2025.

Submissions should be sent to polioresearch@who.int and include the completed application form,

In order to be considered, applicants must submit a complete research proposal by the deadline. To guide the development of your proposal, please read the **detailed guidelines** on how to prepare a proposal for submission to the Polio Research Committee. Applications that are incomplete or have missing parts will not be considered. If a proposal is considered to meet

our priorities, it will be forwarded to the Committee for their consideration.
