Who can apply for a Halton Foundation Grant?



A Halton Foundation grant is typically awarded to a non-profit organization researching how to improve human wellbeing in indoor environments. Grants may also be applied by organizations that develop solutions aiming for better indoor environmental quality.

## What kind of grants are awarded?

- One-time grants which are single-year grants for a specific purpose
- Multi-year grants for no longer than three years; and,
- Start-up program grants

Grants are awarded based on grant applications. The application period is from July 1<sup>st</sup> to September 1<sup>st</sup>

A decision on grants is made by **November 1<sup>st</sup>**. The successful applicant will be notified of the grant award and the grant decision will be announced on the Halton Foundation website.



Depending on the scope and nature of the project or program, the amount of the grant may vary between thousands of dollars and tens of thousands of dollars. Grants shall not exceed 30 000 € per year.

Grants have been awarded in several areas including helping children with asthma, funding for the Himalayas Stove project, and providing grants to universities that research indoor environmental quality.
