Description

Eligibility

Psychologists with up to 12 years of postdoctoral experience.

Applicants must be affiliated with a nonprofit charitable, educational, or scientific institution, or governmental entity operating exclusively for charitable and educational purposes.

Have demonstrated competence and capacity to execute the proposed work.

Institutional review board approval must be received from host institution before funding can be awarded if human participants are involved.
