Each year, the ULF welcomes researchers from around the world to submit their research project proposals for funding consideration.

Applications will be accepted from September 1st through October 13th, 2025.

Applications involving leukodystrophy research with budgets up to \$30,000 (plus up to 10° indirect costs) are welcome to apply. The ULF Medical and Scientific Advisory Board will review applications for scientific merit, feasibility, and likelihood to advance the field. Funding will be awarded by the end of December for utilization during the following calendar year.

To apply: Complete the Research Grant Application and submit it electronically to office@ulf.org by 11:59 pm on October 13th.

Funded investigators will be invited to present their research at a future ULF Scientific Symposium in the Chicago, Illinois area.
