## **Grants**

The VHLA's Competitive Research Grant program awards three types of Grants: One (1) Pilot Grant, one (1) Research Grant, and two (2) Postdoctoral Fellowship Grants.

The Pilot Grant (\$25,000 for one year) is designed to encourage new and existing VHL researchers to explore important issues and pursue paradigm-shifting ideas and approaches to VHL diagnosis, treatment, and prevention. The Research Grant (\$100,000 over 2 years) is designed to support studies that will contribute new insights into the basic biology of VHL, the development of new treatment options, or improve VHL detection/prevention. The Postdoctoral Fellowship grants (\$100,000 each over 2 years) will be awarded to attract and support promising postdoctoral scientists embarking on careers dedicated to VHL research.

Applications will be accepted by invitation only, based on an investigator-submitted Letter of Intent (LOI). The LOI should not exceed one page in length and should include the following:

- 1. Name of the principal investigator (PI);
- 2. Brief description of the PI's qualifications to undertake the proposed project;

- 3. The type of award being sought (i.e., Pilot, Research, or Postdoctoral Fellowship);
- 4. Brief description of the project to be proposed, emphasizing the relevance to VHL disease. The description should include a brief background, hypothesis, specific aims, significance to the field of VHL research, and/or impact on the care of VHL patients.


